

2022 Country Junior District Competition

8 – 11 years

The Country Junior District Competition returned to the Swimming Victoria Competition Calendar after 3 years of cancellations.

The Ovens & Murray had 49 swimmers competing in a total of 171 individual events and 12 relays on Saturday 5th November, for many of our swimmers this was their first time representing the District and the opportunity to swim at MSAC.

50 metre Butterfly events

Girls 11 years – 3rd place to Eden O’Connell

Boys 11 years – 2nd Place to Fraser Nagle with a time of 35.19

Girls 10 years – 4th to Arabella Chapman

Boys 10 years – 2nd place to Cooper Scott

Mixed Multi-Class – 2nd to Mia Hogan

Girls 9 years – 1st to Sophie Clifton with teammate Emmi DeMamiel coming in 3rd place.

Boys 9 Years – four in the top 10 for this event, 1st Leo Palmer, 2nd Sam Mack, 5th Claye Corcoran and 6th Ethan Wilson.

50 metre Backstroke

Girls 11 years – 5th place to Alexandra Wilson

Boys 11 years – another pb to Fraser Nagle bringing him home in 2nd place.

Girls 10 years – 3rd to Ciara Delany

Boys 10 years – 2nd for Max Hall and a pb.

Mixed Multi-Class – 1st to Mia Hogan swimming a pb for this event.

Girls 9 years – switching places in this event 1st to Emmi DeMamiel with Sophie Clifton coming in 2nd, both girls swimming pb’s

Boys 9 years – five in the top 10, 2nd to Sam Mack, 3rd Leo Palmer, 5th Dylan Dickson, 7th Ethan Wilson and 10th to Claye Corcoran.

Boys 8 years – Taylor Drinkwater came in 5th for this event with a pb time of 55.06.

4 x 50 Medley Relay

Girls 11 years - 3rd place went to Alexandra Wilson, Maeve Dwyer, Eden O'Connell and Maeve Beath, swimming 3 seconds faster than their entry time.

Boys 11 years - Also coming home in 3rd place were Finn Angwin, Fletcher Davies, Fraser Nagle, and Benjamin Scott.

Girls 10 years – Ciara Delany, Alexis Delaney, Arabella Chapman, and Mckenzie Drinkwater came 2nd in this event.

Boys 8 years – 9th to Reg Colson and 10th for William Bergin.

50 metre Freestyle

Girls 11 years – 2nd place to Maeve Beath, 4th place went to Isla James, both girls swam pb's.

Boys 11 years – another podium finish for Fraser Nagle coming in 1st and 3rd going to Fletcher Davies.

Girls 10 years – 4th to Ciara Delany.

Boys 10 years – 2nd place to Cooper Scott, with Max Hall not far behind him coming in 6th.

Mixed Multi-Class – another 1st place to Mia Hogan

Boys 9 years – 2nd to Sam Mack swimming a time of 36.63 a pb, 4th to Dylan Dickson
