



All Juniors

Due to the unforeseen circumstances on Sunday at the All Juniors heats and having to put a halt to the meet, the balance of the All Junior Heats will take place as part of Day 1 of the Ovens & Murray Championships on Saturday 23rd February, to take place in Yarrowonga, warm up at 1.00pm, competition commences at 2.00pm.

We have applied for and received written confirmation to submit late entries to Swimming Victoria for the all Junior semi-finals.

The following will be implemented.

All Juniors – Swimmers that were entered in the All Junior Heats will automatically be entered in the Ovens & Murray Championships events that correspond with the events that still need to be run for All Juniors. Swimmers entered in All Junior freestyle events 58 to 76 will be entered in O&M Championship events 3 to 21, the All Junior Breaststroke events 42 to 57 will now be entered in O&M Championship Breaststroke events 62 Multi Class, 65 Boys 9years and events 67 to 80.

Swimmers will not be awarded points towards Ovens & Murray Championships nor will they be eligible to medal.

Ovens & Murray Championships – Swimmers that were entered in All Juniors and wish to also participate in the Ovens & Murray Championships will need to enter online and pay the entry fee, this will allow swimmers to medal and score points towards Age Champion and for their clubs. Times will be uploaded into both Ovens & Murray championships and the All Junior heats, Results will be included in both All Junior Heats and the Ovens & Murray Championships, these will be published as separate Meets.

11 and Under Bathers Rule

As All Juniors is a Swimming Victoria Meet, the 11/U Bathers Rule will be enforced for Heats at Yarrowonga and Finals in Melbourne. All 11/U swimmers will need to adhere to this rule.



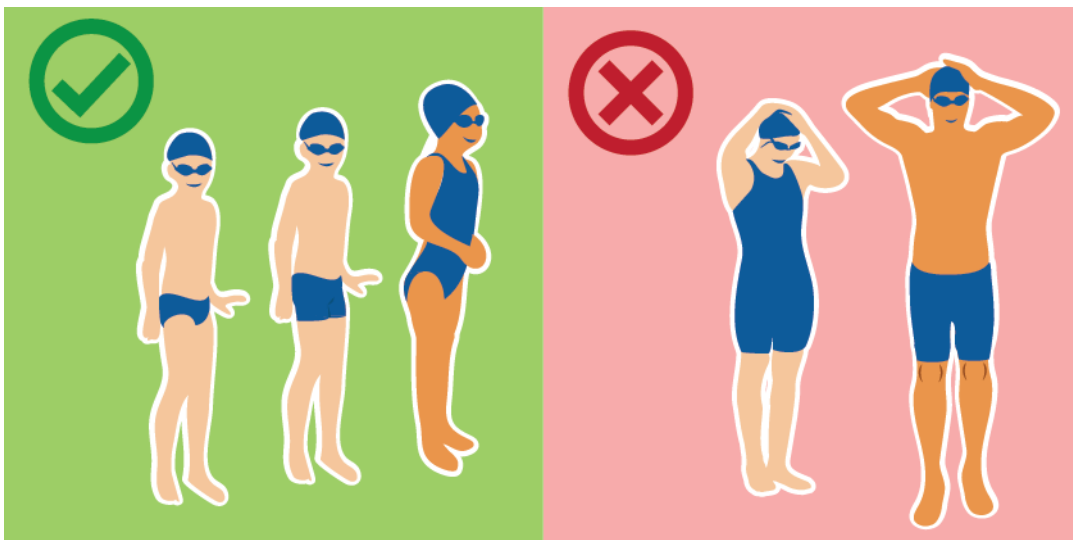
11/UNDER RACE SUITS

Guidelines for Swimming Victoria Technical Officials

This information is for Technical Officials in applying Swimming Victoria's rule in relation to race suits for 11 and under swimmers at SV meets.

It is intended as a guide to the interpretation of the rule and Technical Officials are advised to continue to use their best judgement. If in doubt please speak to the meet referee.

The diagram below should assist you.



As a 'rule of thumb', for boys, suits that finish closer to the hip than to the knee are acceptable. See below.

Examples of Aqua Shorts/Trunks/Classic Briefs Allowed (examples only):



For girls, traditional style one or two piece bathers are permitted.

In no circumstances are suits with zips or fasteners allowed.
