

Victorians on the World Stage



Swimming Victoria recently sent a team to represent Victoria to an international swimming meet. 8 athletes who are on the pathway to senior team selection travelled to Singapore in June and competed at the 2018 Singapore National Championships.

Following the Australian Selection Trials on the Gold Coast and Australian Age Championships in Sydney, athletes who achieved the required times were then ranked based on FINA points with the top 4 males and top 4 females selected.

The Ovens & Murray are proud to have had one of our swimmers selected to represent Victoria, Zoe Deacon (Wodonga Amateur Swimming Club) competed in 5 individual events: the 50,100 and 200metre Breaststroke and the 200 and 400metre Individual Medley, Zoe won a bronze medal in the women 200m Breaststroke.



Zoe also competed in two relay events with team mates Sophie Caldwell, Julia Hawkins and Paris Vasta. The girls took out Gold in both the 4 x 100metre Freestyle relay and the 4 x 100metre Medley relay.
